



Covid-19 participant policy 10/4/2021:

If a **participant** is tested by a healthcare provider and both rapid and PCR test types are administered, results from both tests must come back negative before the **participant** is allowed to return. **Participants** that get sick while participating in the seven-day rapid testing protocol to forego quarantine:

- To avoid quarantine, **participants** must remain symptom-free AND always receive a negative result during this seven-day period. If the **participant** ever receives a positive result, they must complete the 10-day isolation period as prescribed by public health. If the **participant** develops symptoms but receives a negative result, they must remain at home until they are symptom-free for 24 hours. It is recommended that these **participants** have a PCR test on or after Day 5 of their seven-day period.

When Participants Are Sick

Participants that are not feeling well should not come to Park District programming for any reason. If your child is feeling sick before program starts, please keep them home and/or get them tested by Fargo Cass Public Health or your provider if you are concerned it may be COVID.

Household Close Contacts

If there is a positive case in your household, the only individuals that are allowed to continue coming to Park District program are those that are fully vaccinated. Anyone that is living in the same home as a positive case and is not fully vaccinated must complete the quarantine period prescribed by public health. Household close contacts should not come to Park District events or facilities for any reason, until their quarantine is over.

Positive Cases

If your **participant** tests positive for COVID-19, your **participant** will be required to remain out for 10 days from the day they tested or 10 days from symptom onset.

Reporting Positive Cases

Participants who test positive for COVID-19, a representative from the ND Department of Health should contact you to establish case dates. It is important that you answer the phone when the NDDoH calls, as they will get you the most accurate return date for everyone in your family as well as official release letters. If you choose not to visit with NDDoH and cannot provide us with an official return letter, **participants** will be required to remain out for 10 days from the day they tested instead of 10 days from symptom onset. The West Fargo Park District will not perform contact tracing.
